

REGISTRATION

1. All residents as defined in the policy on Residency are entitled to register for and receive an Eagle Mountain Public Library card, subject to the provisions of this policy.
2. Residents may register for and receive library cards free of charge. Residents will be charged fees only for replacing lost and damaged cards, as established in the appropriate policy.
3. In order to register for a library card, individuals are required to provide proof of identification and residency. Two forms of identification are required. A driver's license or student ID is preferred; however any other official ID or recent non-personal piece of mail may be acceptable.
4. Non-residents, who are residents of the State of Utah, may register for an Eagle Mountain Public Library card for \$80 for one year. The non-resident fee entitles the registrant to a family card which will allow multiple immediate family members access to the library for the year.
5. All library cards expire after two years. In order to renew a library card, patrons must provide identification and must clear all outstanding fines and bills.
6. All patrons, adult and juvenile, are expected to bring their library cards with them if they intend to check out library materials.
